

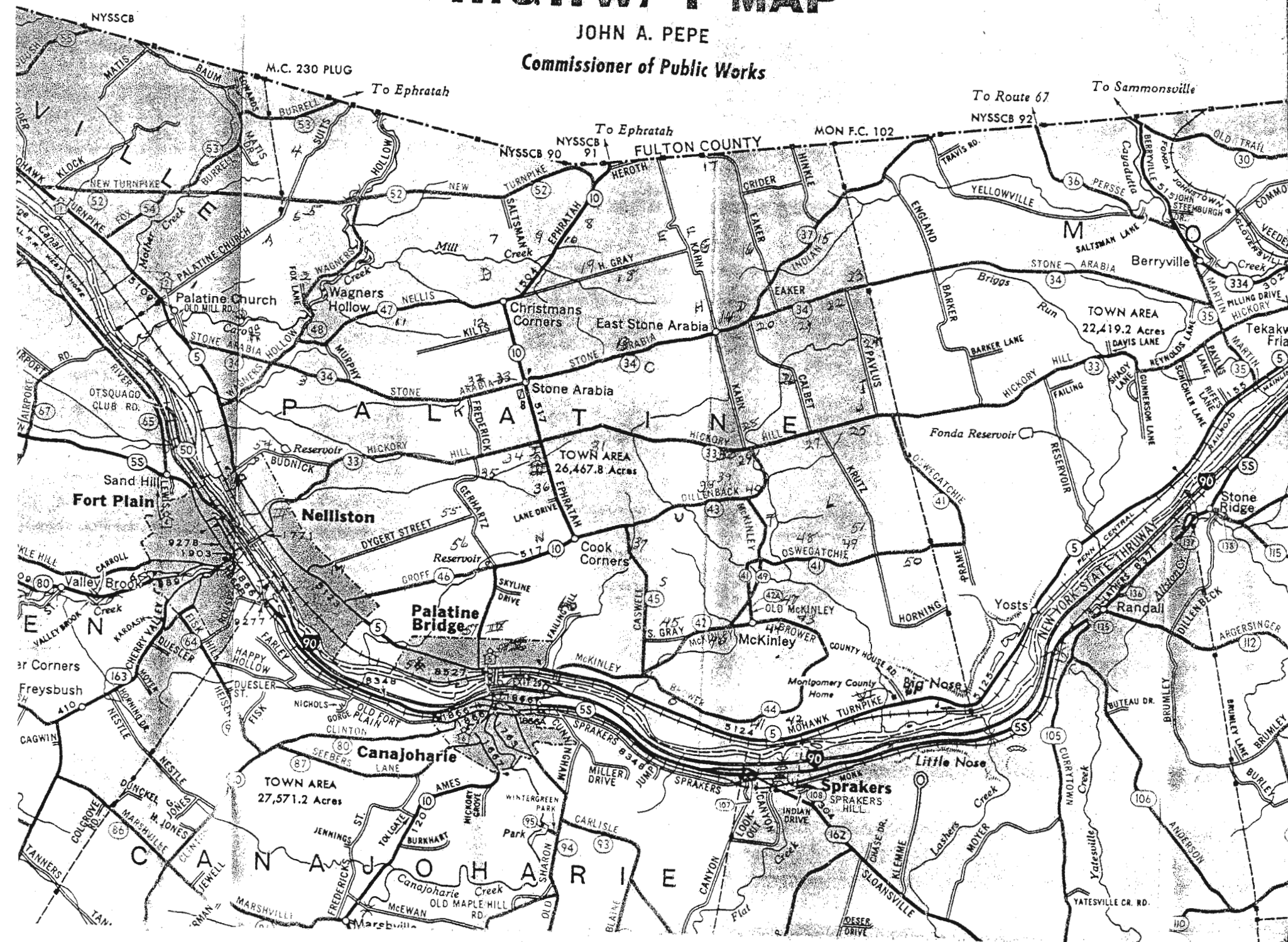

V PALATINE BRIDGE CEMETERY - NUMBER 2  
(Palatine Bridge Cemetery Association)

Location: On the hillside on the east side of Tilton Road.  
At the dead end of street, north side of Route 5 just east of the traffic signal.

Condition: Well built stone and cement walls and paths on three levels. Maintained by a Cemetery Association Board. Third level down are the oldest stones. At the western edge is a pile of stones which have fallen down or are broken. Piled quite carefully. One large monument also seems out of place.

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An older record exists in the Fonda Archives prepared in 1921 by Leland Rickard - Meyer. It covers those cemeteries in the East Stone Arabia, also some of those near the churches. The inscriptions are more complete than those in Greene's List and each list is followed by a map showing the location of the numbered names. In some cases, dates differ, particularly those involving 1 - 4 - 9.

In this listing, the first date indicated will be from Greene's list with that from L. Meyer's following immediately as : 1819 / 1849. Probably the stones were more readable in 1921. When more names are included in the earlier list, it will be so indicated and the extra ones listed following Greene's.

C Stone Arabia Road - East of Route 10 - WICK CEMETERY (Gone)

P- OLD INDIAN BURYING GROUND -

Old name for group of field stones near Railroad tracks (east) not far from the ravine at the northern border of Nelliston, and the old road to the island bridge.

Reported by John Floyd in letter of 1977, confirmed by Mrs. Charlotte Diefendorf, who lived in area until married.

Close to properties of Walrath, who ran ferry, and Wagner's Inn.

Some stones still standing were found in 1981 by Wm. Amthor who walked up tracks and searched.

Q- Reported by Daniel Nellis, Sr. (now deceased)

A number of burials were about 75' to 80' to north of of Caroga Creek, about  $\frac{1}{4}$  mile above the Bridge at Palatine Church. Burials were in a steep slope of shale or slate.

A cave-in when he was young buried the graves deeply. He was quite sure that some may have been moved to village cemetery.

R- Reported by Alvah B. Waffle, who was a town employee working for Clayton Greene, Supt. of Roads.

When removing gravel for road work, in a gravel bed to the northwest of Stock Road (old name for section of Stone Arabia Road across from Nellis Stock Farm), they found some burials deep below the gravel. Machines had broken wooden boxes and broken into one that had been bricked in.

S- Reported by Joseph Pamkowski, who lives on east side of Caswell Road in McKinley, on farm marked J. Rice on Map of 1868.

He has been told that there was once a cemetery in pasture to southeast of his house, but all bodies were moved to village.

T- Reported by Mrs. Florence (Winsman) Van Wie, who remembers it when a child. Stones were badly broken even then. She recalls only one name: (Wood). (Not sure of that).

Located in the corner nearest the road, in the pasture just to the south of the former Winsman home on the east side of Oswegatchie Road., between Dillenbeck and McKinley Roads.

U- Reported by Glenn Sitterly in a letter to the County Historian, Anita Smith in 1978. It was located on the south side of Dillenbeck Road to the right of the stone house - built by Josiah Sitterly in 1867. Only a few stones were left when bodies were moved to Fort Plain in 1914. It is now gone
